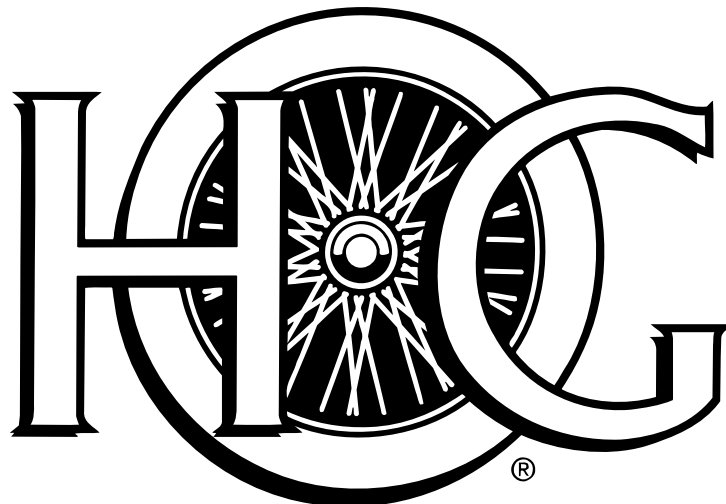
A Big Thanks!
