

NEWS FROM THE DIRECTOR

December has arrived! So as one riding season comes to a close, plans are being made for our next riding season. Officers, road captains, and some of our activity coordinators met on November 30 to put together our events calendar for 2009. We will try to have a copy of the calendar ready for our December meeting, one will be emailed to you as soon as it is done. For those who do not have e-mail, a copy will be available at the December meeting, or at Kutters after that date. We will not mail copies out separately. They will also be available at the January meeting and in the January newsletter.

One of the bylaw requirements of H.O.G. is that we identify all events as either open, closed, or member events.

OPEN EVENTS: Those chapter events that are open to Swiss Valley Chapter members, national HOG members and any other guests as desired.

CLOSED EVENTS: Those chapter events open to chapter members and 1 guest per member.

MEMBER EVENTS: Those events open only to Swiss Valley Chapter members.

We need to identify each event in order to post the calendar on our website.

It was decided at our November meeting that the officers and road captains will each plan a dinner ride for the 2009 riding season. We are going to try to stay within 30 miles of Monroe for our evening dinner rides in order to get people home as early as possible for those who don't like to ride after dark, or for those who have to leave for work early mornings. We will still be leaving Kutter at 6:00 PM for our weekday dinner rides, but it will not be on the 3rd Wednesday during 2009. It was decided to move the rides to some Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday evenings, some Saturday and Sunday afternoons. This will hopefully give everyone a chance to make a few of the rides that had commitments on Wednesday evenings. We will review again at the end of the year to see if we have had better attendance.


Friday Dinner Ride/Drive
