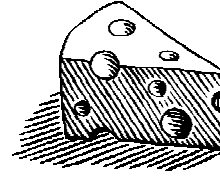
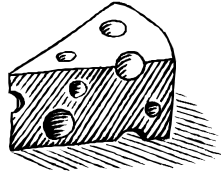

Safety Officer Corner

As of June 19th, the Department of Transportation is reporting that so far this year there have been 37 motorcycle rider fatalities and one passenger. At this time last year the count was 38 riders and 5 passengers. Of course, we all strive to ride safely but here are just a couple of reminders. Alcohol has been a factor in a number of these fatalities. Alcohol and motorcycling are a combination that can leave you breathless. Increase your alertness in the early morning and at dusk to avoid deer/ motorcycle collisions. Avoiding riding at night if possible. When you must ride at night, reduce your speed and ride with your high beams on so you can increase your chances of reacting to the sudden appearance of these animals. Finally, when encountering other vehicles with the potential to turn left in front of you, slow your speed and be ready to use your braking controls. Watch for movement of the front tire of the vehicle which may indicate it's about to pull into your path. A motorist may be looking at you, but it doesn't mean they actually see you. Don't allow someone whose mind is occupied elsewhere to turn you into a hood ornament.

On another note, the first aid class is set for the 16th and 17th of August. It will be held at Blackhawk Tech here in Monroe. It's the American Heart version and the cost is \$48.00 with an additional cost for the text book of \$20.00. If you have taken the class in the last four years, you can use that book. The class is from 6:00 pm to 9:30 pm both nights and results in a two year certification. The following people have indicated that they will take the class. Jeff, Hokie, Fuzzy, Darryl Panke, Barb Smith, her daughter Tracy Spotts. We must have two more persons to fill the class and can have as many as ten. More than that requires another instructor and up to sixteen people. All personal information previously gathered has been destroyed and registration papers will be filled out the first night of the class. The fee for the training must be given to Scott Golackson by August 1, 2010. Please get these fees to him in a timely manner. This class has been slow to materialize but it is now approaching fast. We need at least two more persons for this class, PLEASE! sign up.
