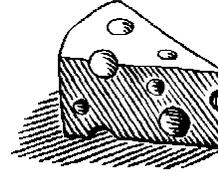
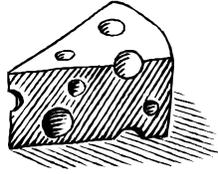

They are collecting toys, household items and toiletries for foster care children and those coming out of Foster care. They are parking the Kutter trailer outside of retail stores to collect items for this organization. He is partners with the Apparitions and Abate, he had the Chapter put on the flyer and asked if anyone could help collect items when they are parked at Walmart next Saturday and at Kutter the following Saturday. Barb S. read a letter from this organization explaining their cause so we could all understand.

Kutter Open House will be Dec. 8th. The chapter will wrap presents again and have a Bake Sale. There will be a sign up at Kutter for wrapping and working the bake sale.

Dec 7th there is a Holiday parade downtown Monroe at 6pm. Kutter will have a float in the parade and will be handing out presents to children on the parade route.
